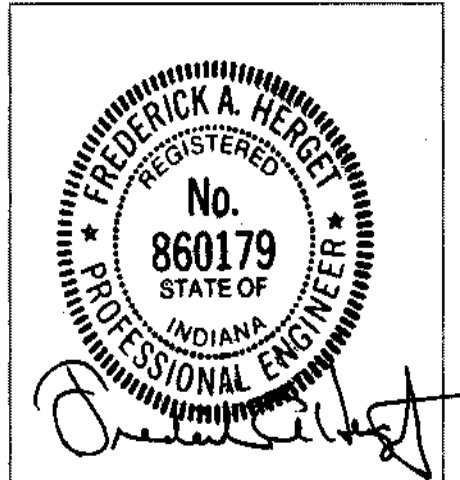

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ADDENDUM No. 2

This addendum is issued in accordance with the provisions of Division 0 - Bidding and Contract Requirements of the Project Manual - Technical Specifications, and becomes a part of the Contract Documents as provided therein.

Acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in the space provided on the Proposal Form. Failure to do so may subject the Bidder to disqualification.

The following section of the Contract Documents, General Conditions are called to the attention of the bidders. Bidders **MUST** submit a written Drug Testing of Employees of Public Works Contractors Plan to have a responsive bid. Acknowledge receipt of this addendum and insert its number in the Bid Form Insert.

54. DRUG TESTING PROGRAM

The laws of the State of Indiana (IC-4-13-18 as amended) contain certain special provisions regarding drug testing of employees of public works Contractors and Subcontractors. Contracts entered into between a Contractor and the Trustees of Purdue University estimated to be in excess of \$150,000.00 will be governed by these provisions. These provisions require, among other things, that the Contractor submit with the bid a written plan for a program to test the Contractor's employees for drugs. In addition, each successful Bidder will be required to comply with all applicable provisions of the statute referred to above with respect to each Bidder's Subcontractors, as the term "Subcontractor" is defined in the statute referred to above.

COMPLIANCE AFFIDAVIT:

Each application for payment shall be accompanied by an affidavit, dated and signed by the Contractor, substantially as follows:

This is to certify that in the performance of this Contract, neither the undersigned Contractor, nor (so far as the undersigned has knowledge) any of its Subcontractors, has violated the "Drug Testing Program" provision of the General Conditions of the Contract.
